## Single Family Construction Permit Fees

Shall be based on square footage multiplied by the cost per square foot as established in the valuation table and fees according to Table 1-A.

Electrical permit fees for Single Family construction shall be **25%** of the building permit fee (Note: temporary power pole fees for new Single Family construction is **\$15.00**).

Plumbing permit fees for Single Family construction shall be **20%** of the building permit fee.

Mechanical permit fees for Single Family construction shall be **10%** of the building permit fee.

## Fence Permit Fees

Fees for fence permits shall be based on the cost of construction as determined in Table 1-A.

## Swimming Pool/Spa/Hot Tub Fees

Fees for swimming pools, spas, and hot tub construction, excluding electrical, shall be based on the cost of construction as determined in Table 1-A.

## Re-Roofing Permit Fees

For re-roofing Single Family structures, or fractions thereof **\$75.00**

For re-roofing Commercial structures, or fractions thereof shall be based on the cost of construction as determined in Table 1-A.

## Demolition Permit Fees

For the demolition of each structure or building, including accessory buildings **\$50.00**

Fees for this type of construction will be based on the **UNIT FEE SCHEDULE**.

For all other types of residential occupancies and alterations, additions, and modifications to existing residential buildings, use the **UNIT FEE SCHEDULE**.

#### Private Swimming Pools

For new private, residential, in-ground swimming pools for Single Family and Multi Family occupancies including a complete system of necessary branch circuit wiring, bonding, grounding, underwater lighting, water pumping and other similar electrical equipment directly related to the operation of a swimming pool, each

## Power Apparatus

For motors, generators, transformers, rectifiers, synchronous converters, capacitors, industrial heating, air conditioners and heat pumps, cooking or baking equipment and other apparatus as follows: Rating in horsepower (HP) kilowatts (KW), kilovolt-amperes (KVA), or Kilovolt-amperes-reactive (KVAE).

### **Sign, Outline Lighting, and Marquees**

For signs, outline lighting systems, or marquees supplied from one branch circuit **\$20.00 Each**

### **Services**

For services or sub panels of 600 volts or less and not over 100 amperes in rating or less **\$25.00 Each**

# SIGN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS AND FEES

## Permanent Signs

Permit Issuance Fee **\$100.00 + 3% of the  
Cost of the Sign**

Permanent Sign applications (Pink) must be completed accompanied by the Permit Issuance Fee, and two sets of drawings of the proposed sign that includes dimensions of the sign.

## Temporary Signs

Permit Issuance Fee **\$65.00**

Temporary Sign applications (Yellow) must be completed accompanied by the Permit Issuance Fee.

Permits for Temporary Signs are valid for 30 days.

A maximum of six permits per year, per individual business is allowed.

No permit shall be issued to an individual business until 30 days has passed since the expiration of any previous sign permit that has been issued.

Balloons will be permitted for 10 days on the first permit issued, and 3 days thereafter.
