Property Tax Rate

The City of Watauga adopts a property tax rate annually as part of the City's budget process. On September 9, 2019, the City Council set the tax rate for 2019 (Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Budget) at \$0.58050, which is a \$.02 decrease from the 2018 tax rate (Fiscal Year 2018-2019). Prior to adopting the tax rate, the City Council held two public hearings to receive public input. Although the City decreased the tax rate from last year, homeowners may see an increase in their property tax bill if the value of their home increased. About 18% of homes in Watauga have their taxes frozen due to the owner being either over 65 or disabled. Property taxes for those homeowners will not go above the amount of taxes they owned in the year their tax freeze was granted.

Annual Property Tax Bill

A resident's overall property tax bill includes taxes assessed by the city, school district, county, county hospital district, and county college district. More than half of your property tax bill is paid to the school district, with about 22% going to the City of Watauga. Each jurisdiction sets their tax rate annually, in conjunction with the adoption of their annual budget. Your property taxes pay for services such as police and fire protection, emergency medical services, community center services, library services, and general tax supported debt.

The following chart shows the tax rates adopted in 2019.

Property Tax Exemptions and Resources

The City offers a \$40,000 senior citizen exemption from assessed values and has adopted the over-65 and disabled citizen tax freeze. All other exemptions for disabled persons and veterans are as stipulated by State Law.

Sales Taxes

In the City of Watauga, the sales tax is currently 8.25%. The sales tax includes:

- ❖ 6.25% for the State of Texas
- ❖ 1% for the City of Watauga General Fund
- ❖ 0.5% for the City of Watauga Crime Control and Prevention District
- ❖ 0.25% for the Watauga Economic Development Corporation
- ❖ 0.25% for the Street Maintenance Fund
